CONCEPT DESIGN

I chose the name Composure for my chair to represent myself; calm under pressure. The style of Composure is bohemian mid-century modern. The legs and base of the chair are made out of ash wood. The chair's back and armrest are made out of black steel shaped as triangles with woven twine on the sides and back. The black steel contrasts the neutral and light colors of the wood and twine. In addition, the twine adds texture to the design. The design of this chair fits the aesthetic of Urban Outfitters and West Elm.

MATERIALS USED

For my model, I used a 1 centimeter thick, square shaped wood board for the base. I placed wooden sticks for the legs to represent the ashwood. To imitate the steel, I used black straws wrapped in twine.
